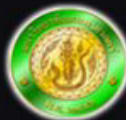

3.2 Rules & Regulations

The latest WKF/AKF Competition rules will be adopted for the Championship unless otherwise notified by the Organizer or the Referee Commission in consultation with the WKF/AKF Executive Council.

3.1 Senior Kumite	3:00 minutes
3.2 Cadet and Junior Kumite	2:00 minutes
3.3 U14 and U12 Kumite	1:30 minutes
3.4 U8 and U10 Kumite	1:00 minute

IV. EQUIPMENT

All competition equipment must comply with the official regulations set by the World Karate Federation (WKF).

Athletes are required to bring their own personal protective equipment for competition. If any equipment is found to be non-compliant with WKF standards, referees reserve the right to disallow the athlete from competing.

V. OFFICIATING REFEREES

Qualified referees are welcome to apply to officiate in the Championship. Referees must hold certification as National Referees or be WKF/AKF certified referees. All referees must register themselves through the SPORTDATA system in advance. Team nomination is not required.

Please note: The Organizing Committee will provide full board accommodation only for AKF Referee Commission (RC) members.

VI. INSURANCE & LIABILITY

All participants, officials, and delegation members are strongly advised to arrange their own personal accident and health insurance coverage prior to their arrival in Thailand.

The Organizing Committee and the Thailand Karate Federation will not be held responsible for any injury, illness, loss, or damage incurred during travel, competition, or stay in Thailand.

Participation in the Karate Thailand Open 2026 is at the sole risk and responsibility of each athlete, coach, or official.

Names of athletes, coaches, or VIPs incorrectly entered into the system will be placed on the Waiting List.

They will only be eligible to participate after full payment (if applicable) or approval by the Organizing Committee. Once approved, their status will be updated to "Approved."

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to allocate hotel bookings only to those who complete both the reservation and payment within the given deadline.

The committee will not be responsible for accommodation issues due to missed deadlines or late arrivals.

Guests who check in with more persons than originally reserved will be subject to a surcharge of USD 80 per additional person.
