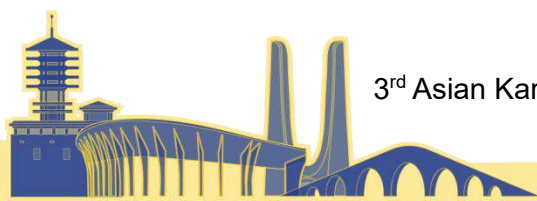

3. The City

3.1. About the City



As the capital of Zhejiang province and a hub for its economy, culture, science, and education, Hangzhou is one of the central cities in the Yangtze River Delta. Renowned as a scenic tourism destination, it also ranks among the first batch of national historical and cultural cities. Located in the southern wing of the Yangtze River Delta and at the western tip of the Hangzhou Bay, it is the crossing point of the extension of the "Silk Road Economic Belt" and "21st Century Maritime Silk Road" and a strategic hub along the "Online Silk Road".

Situated at the juncture of 29°11'-30°34' North and 118°20'-120°37' East, Hangzhou features a perfect blending of hill and water, and lake and town, with rich water resources, and a ubiquitous yet harmonious presence of rivers, canals, lakes, sea, creeks. Such picturesque natural view has earned the fame of "Paradise on Earth" for millenniums. Throughout its territory, hilly or mountainous areas account for 65.6% and are largely concentrated in the west, middle and south; plains amount to 26.4%, mainly found in the northeast; surface area of rivers, lakes and reservoirs takes up 8.0%. Its forest coverage ranks top among the nation's provincial capitals-up to 65.33%.

Hangzhou boasts the largest reservoir in China's southern coast - the Xin'an River Reservoir (also known as Qiandao Lake) and the world's longest artificial canal – the Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal. Traversing the city is Qiantang River, widely known for its spectacular tidal waves.



3.2. How to get to City



Hangzhou International Airport (HGH) is located in the east of Hangzhou City, Zhejiang Province, 27 kilometers away from the city center, and is the first air portal of Zhejiang Province as it is an important trunk-line airport, an international scheduled flight airport, a first-class airport open to the outside world and alternate airport for international flight in China.

3.3. Weather

Hangzhou enjoys a subtropical monsoon climate, characterized by distinct seasons, ample sunlight, and abundant rainfall. Spring and autumn are relatively short, while winter and summer last longer.

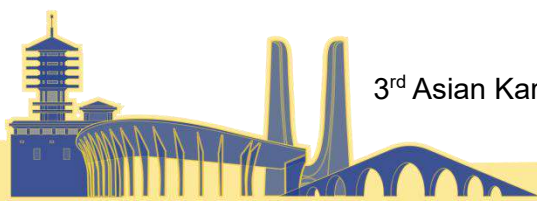
The weather in Hangzhou in July is very hot. The average temperatures are between 25°C and 33°C, drinking water regularly is advisable. There's going to be many days of rain during the month of July in Hangzhou. Hangzhou should expect an average of 15 to 22 days of rain, so be sure to bring along a waterproof jacket to stay dry this month!

3.4. Currency

The Chinese yuan renminbi (simplified Chinese: 人民币), or CNY, which means 'people's currency', is the official currency of the People's Republic of China.



However, for payment method, China is primarily a cashless and cardless economy, with the vast majority of shoppers using their phones (digital wallets) to pay for items in person and online.

Digital wallets **WeChat Pay** and **Alipay** are China's two most popular payment methods, accounting for more than 90 per cent of the mobile payments market.

Meanwhile UnionPay is the only card scheme in China, it issues debit and credit cards, links all ATMs in the country, provides merchants with EPOS (electronic points of sale) machines, and offers online and mobile payment services.

3.5. Electricity

In China, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type A, type C and Type I are used. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz.

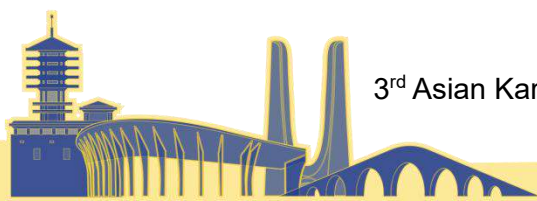

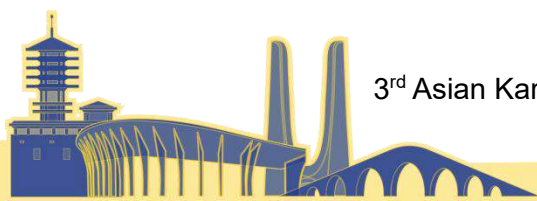
1. Parents/guardians requiring an accreditation card must register through Sportdata. Those registered in accordance with Chapter 7 and pay the all-in price will receive the same entitlements as the athletes, including hotel accommodation with breakfast, airport and local transportation, and an accreditation card granting access to the designated.
2. Parents/guardians may also choose not to stay at the official hotel, opting instead to receive only an accreditation card and airport transfers, at a cost of USD 100.

5.3. Training Camp Venue

Training will be conducted in SPORTS CENTER GYMNASIUM IN LINPING DISTRICT, HANGZHOU, CHINA

Address: Sports Center, No. 177 South Donghu Road, Linping District, Hangzhou, Zhejiang Province.





The stadium covers an area of 8,383 square meters, with a building area of 16,885 square meters. The central court is 46 meters long and 28.5 meters wide, with 4,200 seats for spectators (of which 900 are movable seats). The Karate event of the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou as well as the 20th Asian Senior Karate Championship and the 3rd Asian Para-Karate Championship were held in this gymnasium.

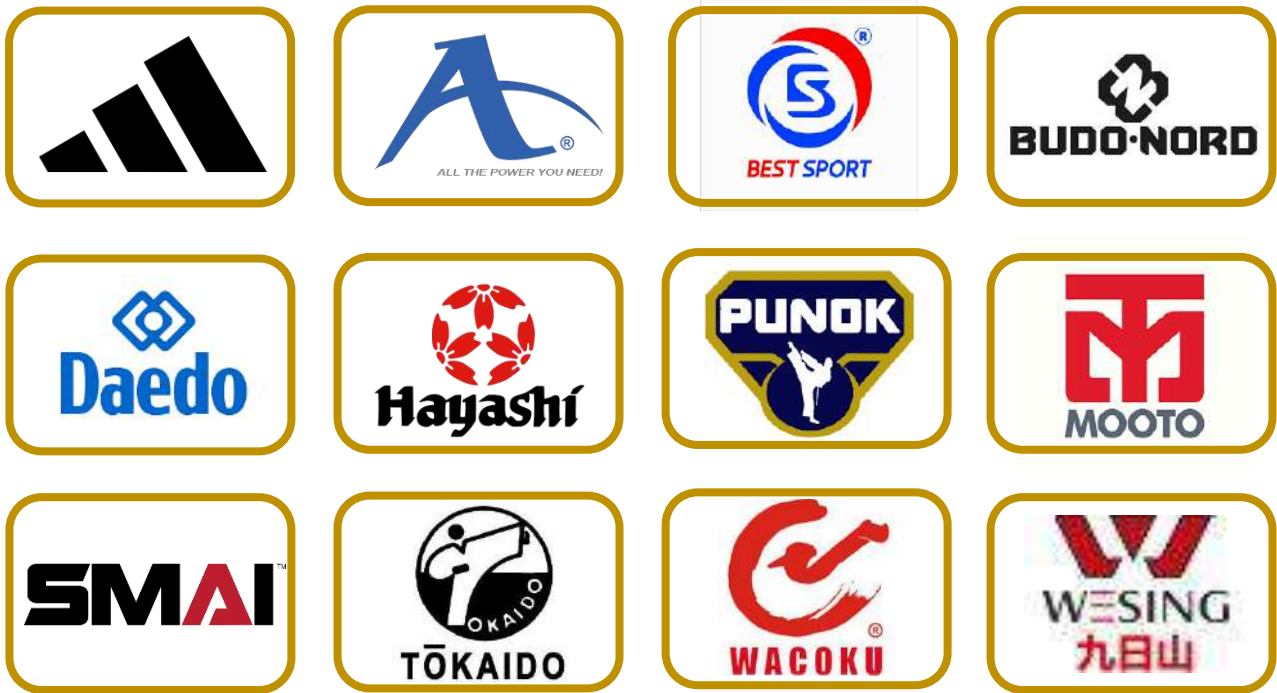

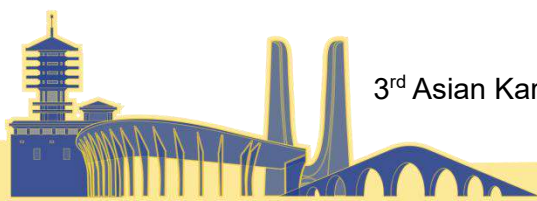

6.1. What the Fee Includes

The all-in participation fee entitles each registered participant to:

- Hotel accommodation for 6 nights (check-in: 21st July, check-out: 27th July), including daily breakfast
- Airport transfer (arrival and departure)
- Local transport between hotel and training/competition venue.
- Participation in **all training seminars (Kata & Kumite)**
- Participation in **up to two (2) competition categories** (e.g., Kata Individual + Kumite Individual, or Kumite in two weight divisions as allowed by age/gender rules)
- The fee is fixed regardless of whether the participant joins both the seminar and competition, the seminar only, or the competition only.
- **For the same club, for every 8 athletes/coaches registered, the 9th athlete/coach is free of charge.**



! Important Notice:

While each participant is allowed to register for up to two competition categories, **in case of scheduling conflicts**, the participant will be required to **choose only one category** to compete in. The AKF and Organizing Committee will not be responsible for timing clashes between categories.

Parents/guardians with an accreditation card may only access designated areas during the training camp and are not permitted to enter the FOP during the championship.

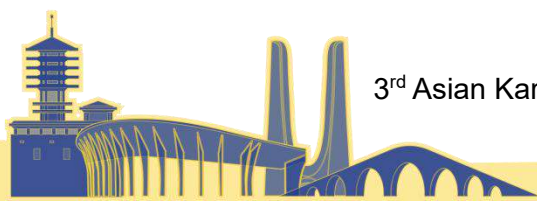

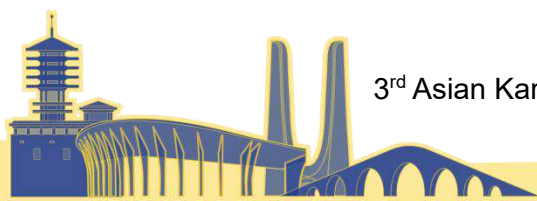

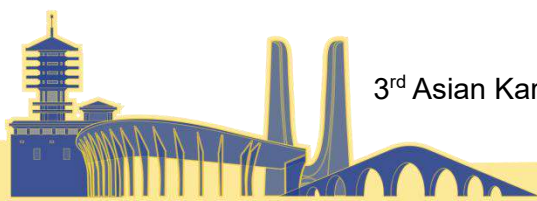
